Chart Compilation

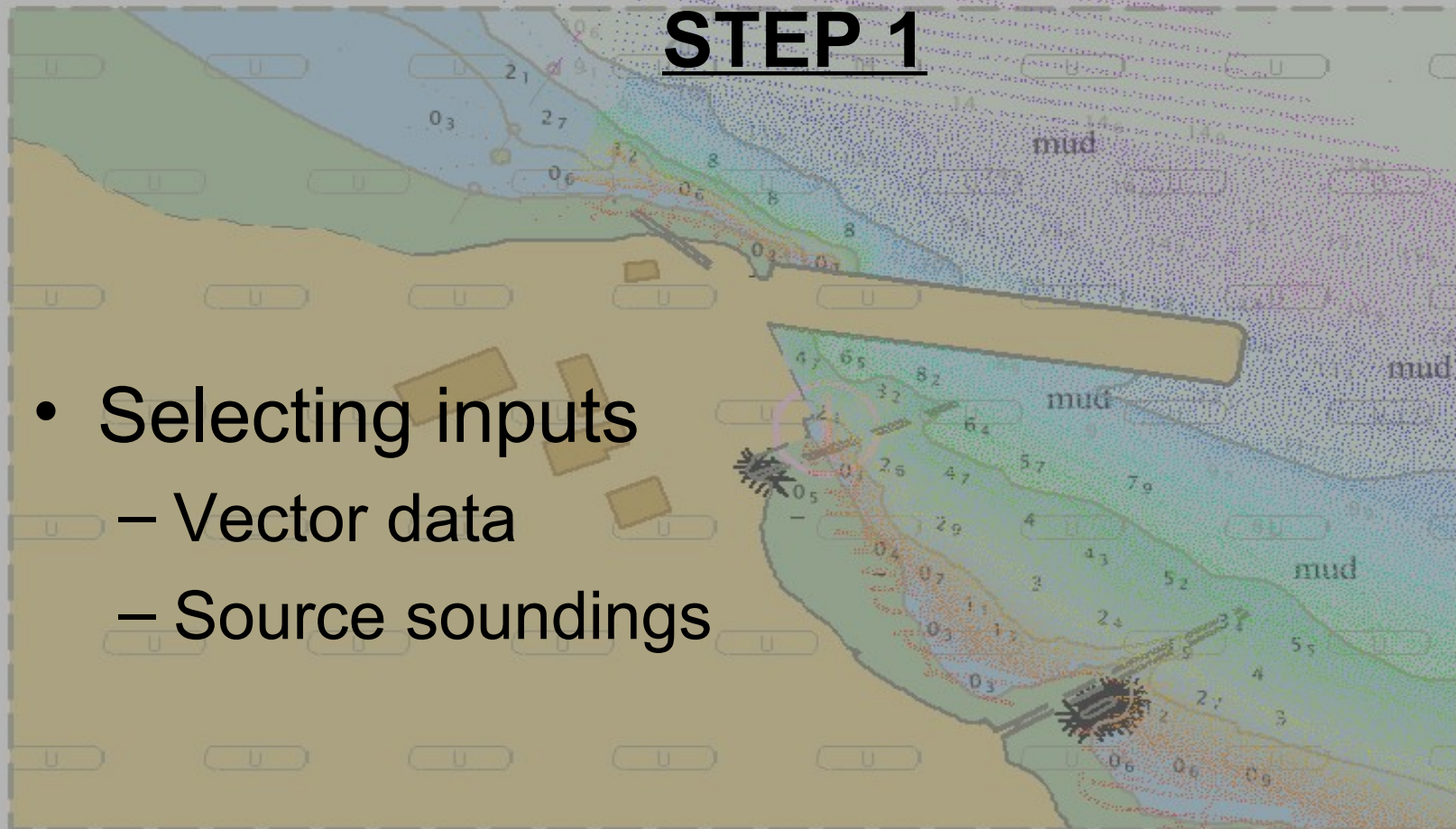
- Old hydrographic problem.
- Even with modern tools, chart compilation implies manual work.
- New technology can help us.
- Automatic compilation, impossible.
- Using technology we can improve compilation time and quality control.

- Contouring



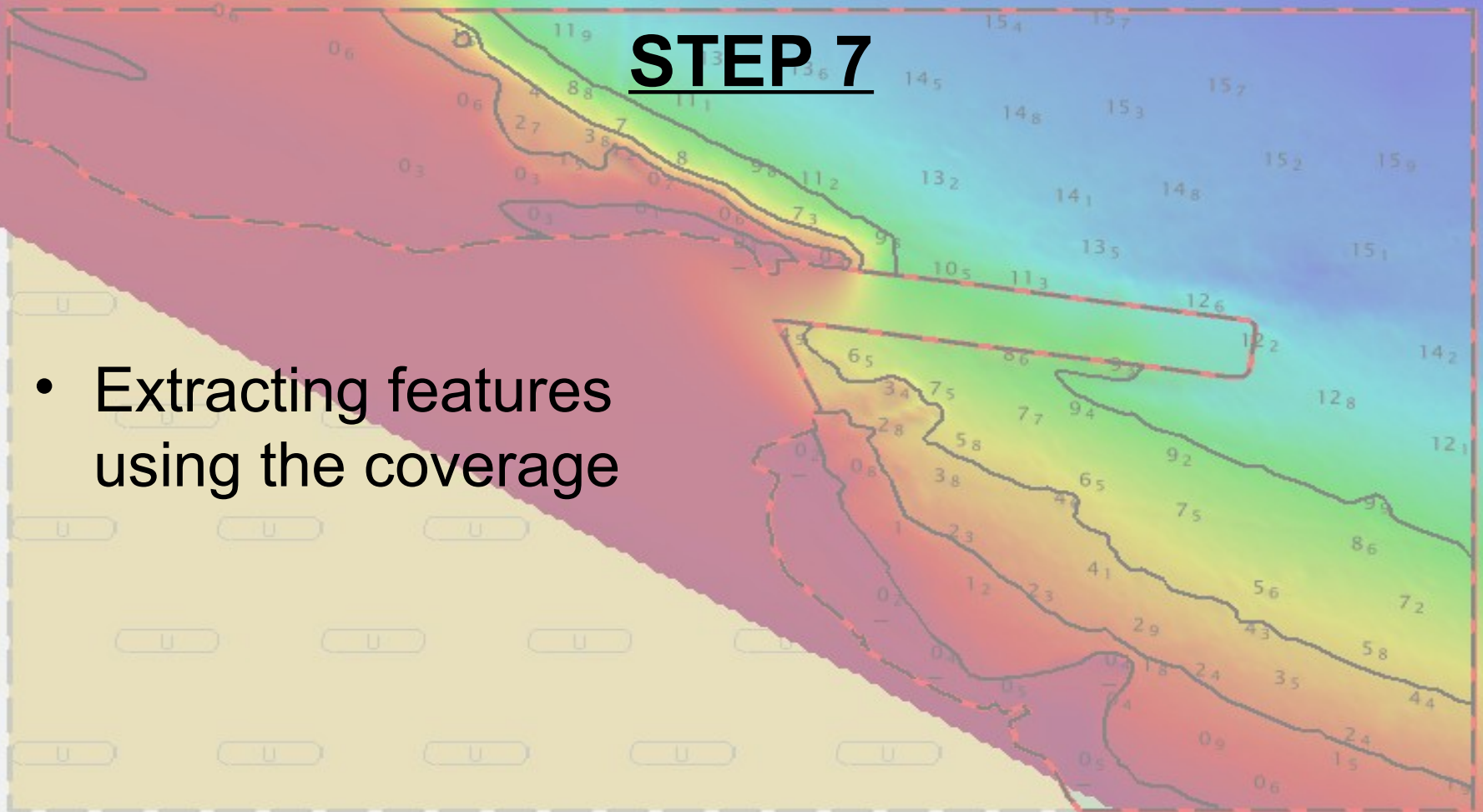

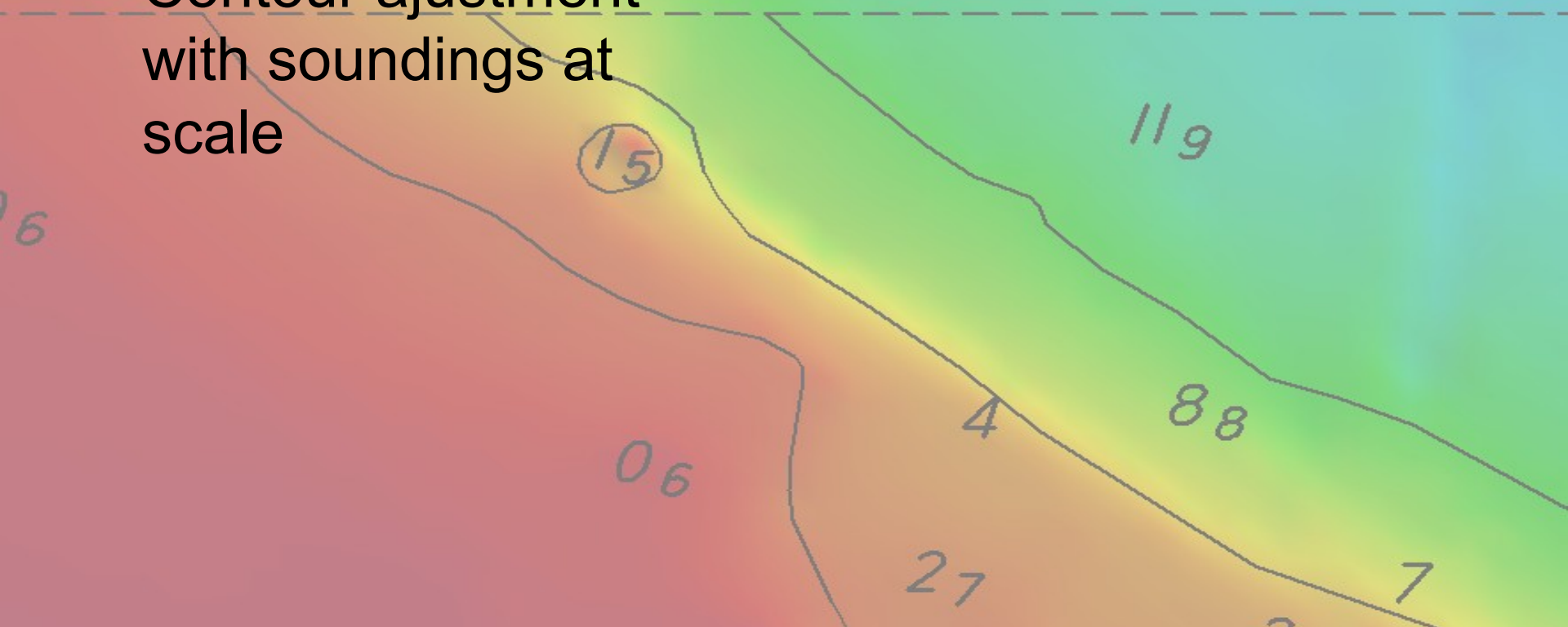

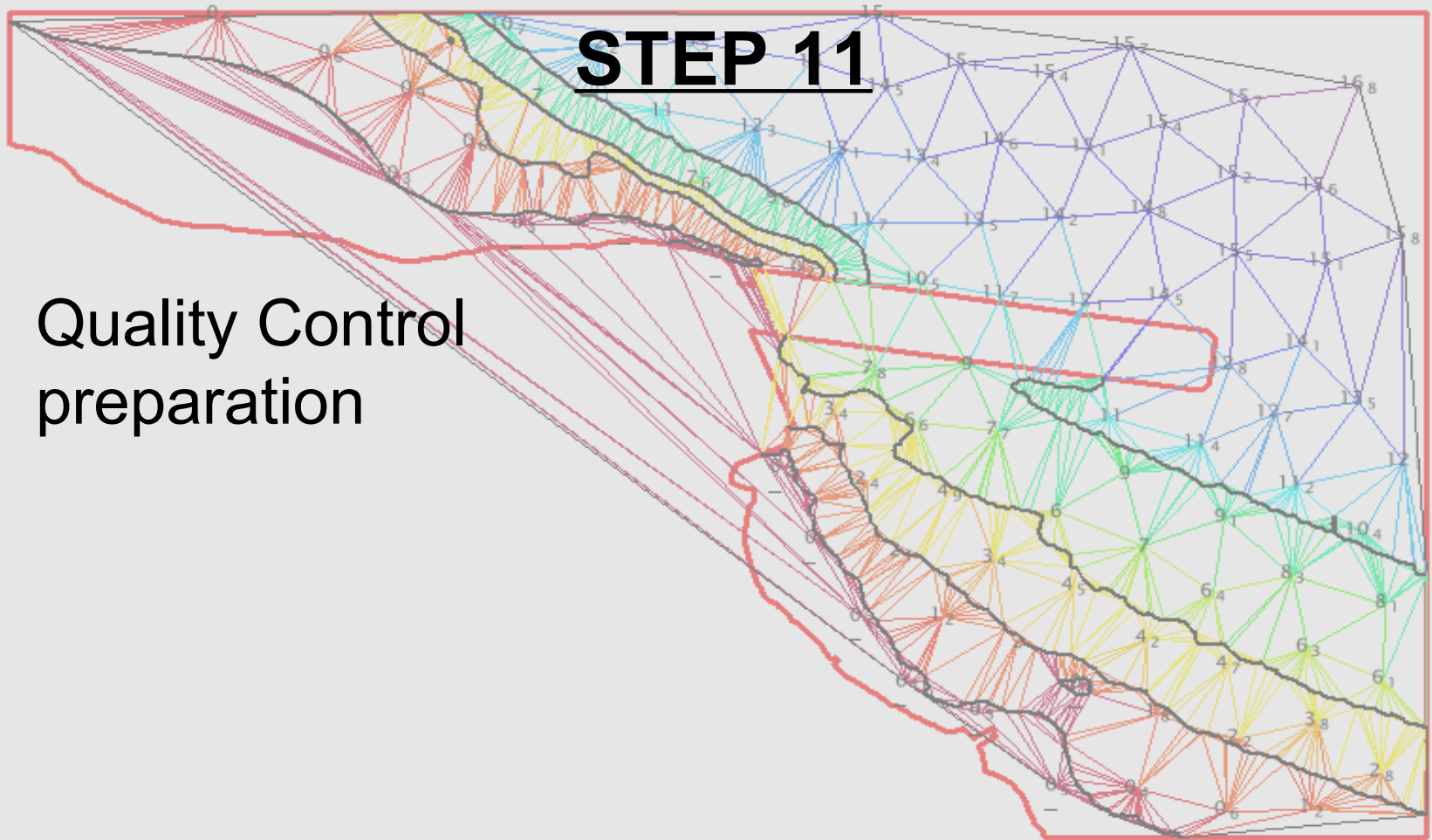
- Contour adjustment with soundings at scale

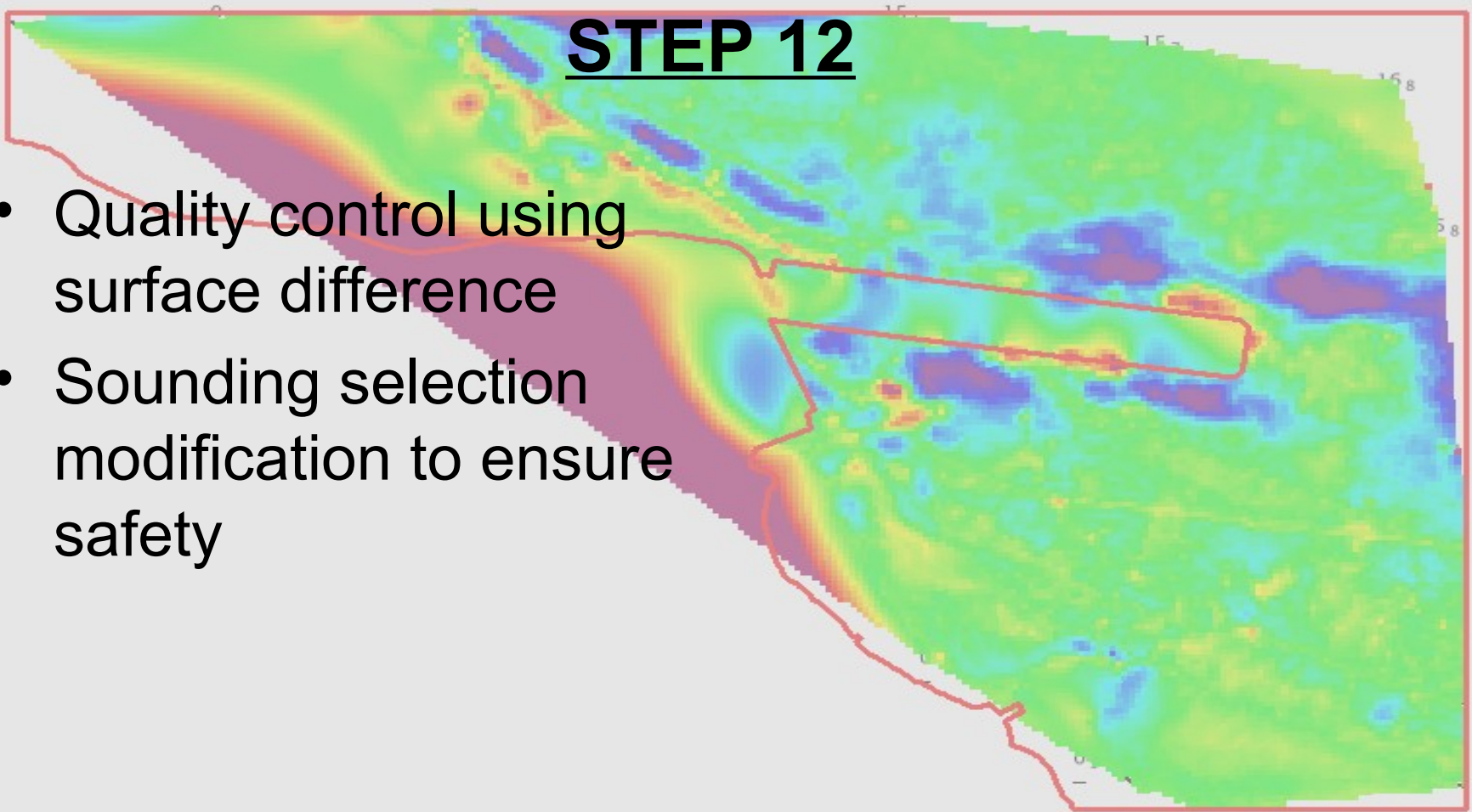

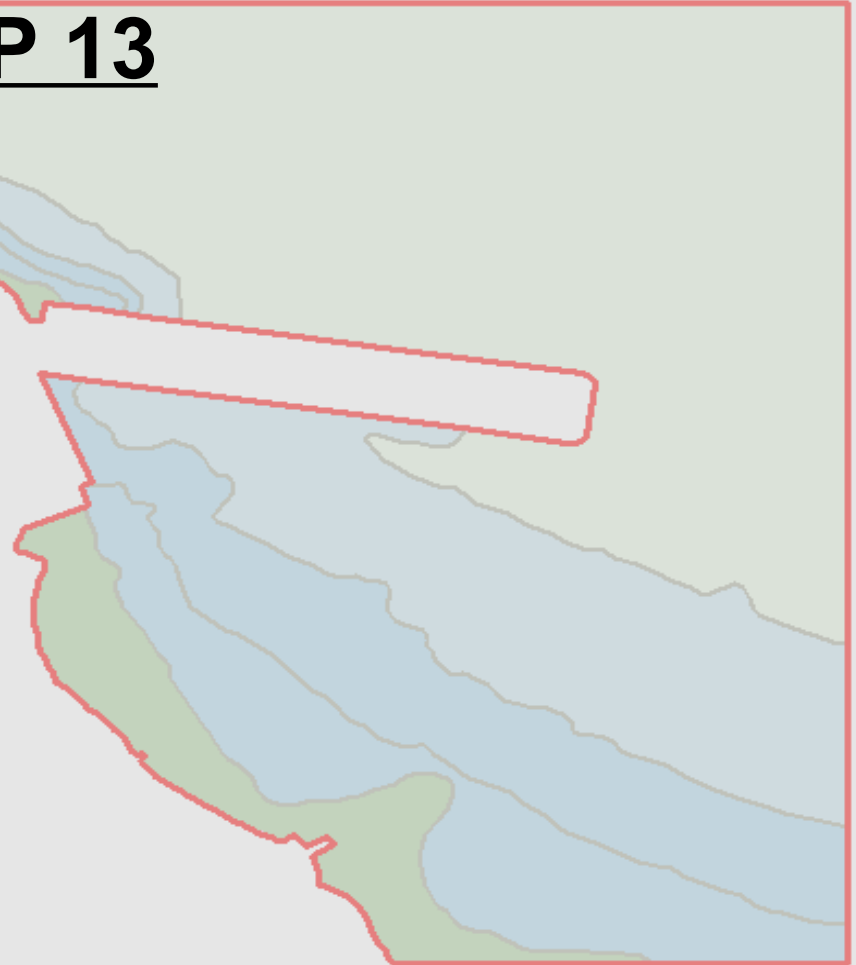
- Quality control using surface difference

- Checking attributes



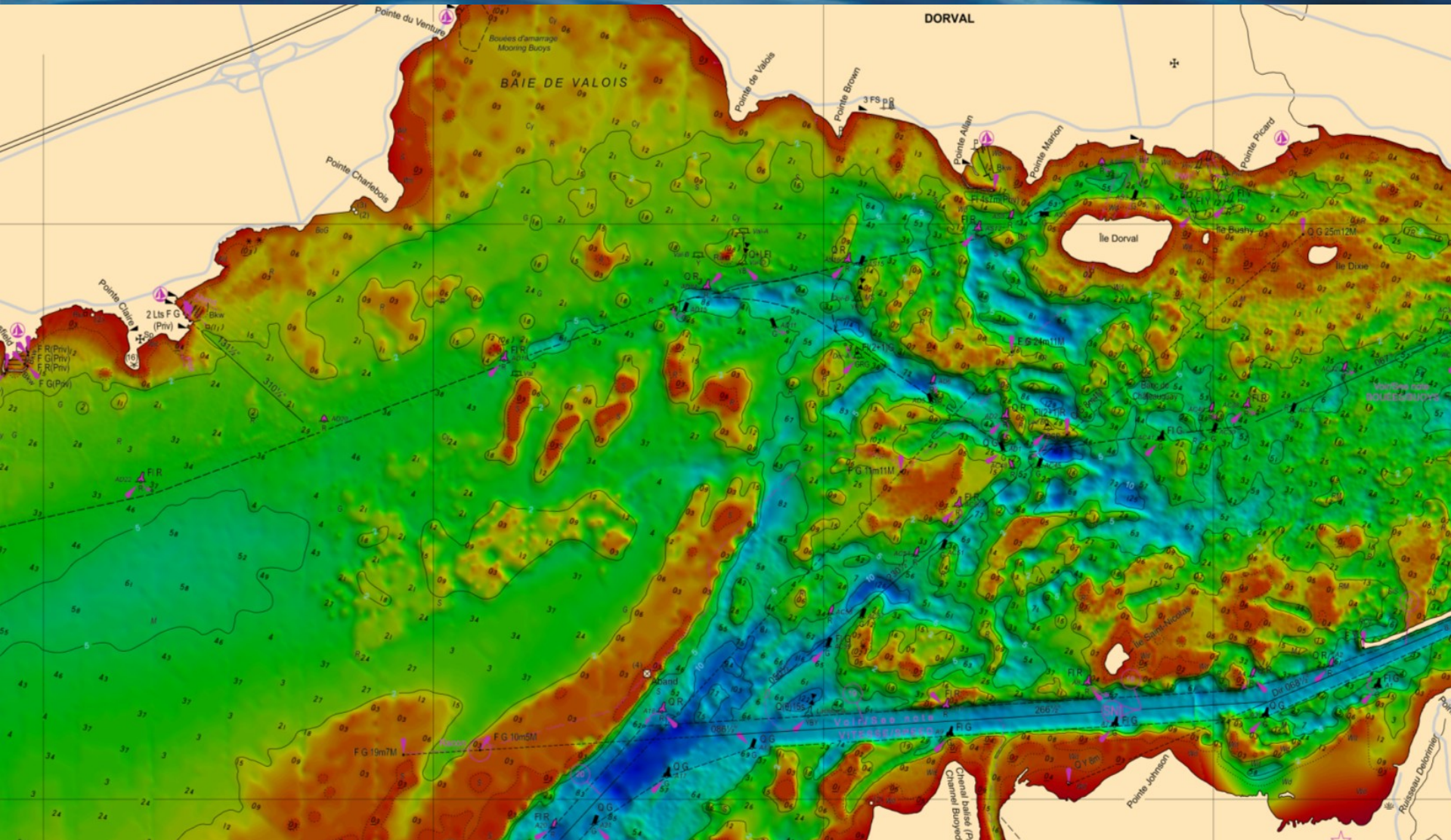
